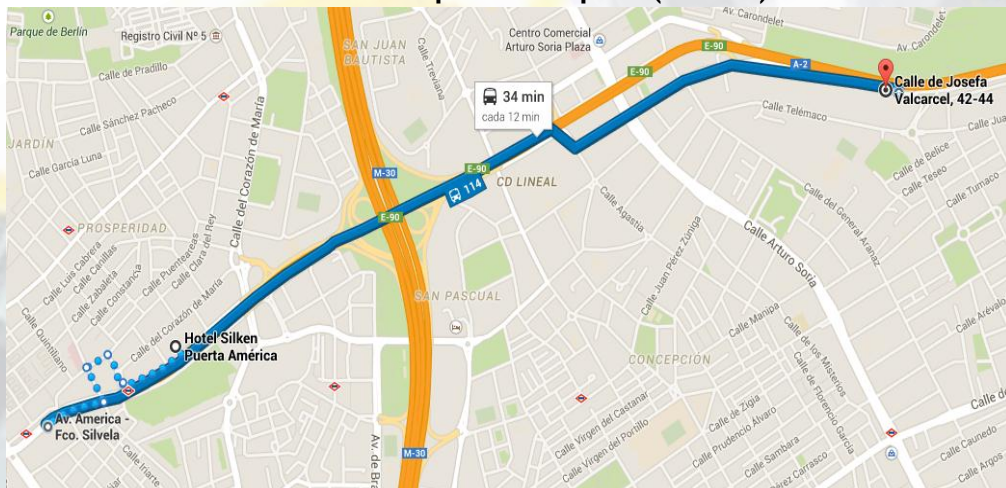

### 1. The organisation of the sessions

### 2. The running of each session

- eCall demonstration from point of view of end users:
  - DGT vehicle equipped with eCall IVS
  - P2W equipped with sensors for accident detection and eCall IVS
  - Motorcycle helmet equipped with sensors for accident detection and communication with the motorcycle
- eCall demonstration from point of view of PSAP operators:
  - Overall presentation of a Traffic Management Centre (TCC/TIC) including whole control and information systems
  - Intermediate PSAP receiving the eCall and forwarding to final 112
  - Managing the received eCall with different interfaces:
    - DGT Traffic Management Centre
      - Traffic Police
      - Traffic incident database
      - National vehicle database
